CREEK TOP COMMUNITY GARDEN USE AGREEMENT

Creek Top Community Garden is a program offered by The 712 Initiative, utilizing property owned by the City of Council Bluffs. Our mission is to provide a gardening opportunity to community residents who may not otherwise have access to garden space.

Below are the basic rules and guidelines each plot holder agrees to:

- Only organic gardening is permitted. No chemical herbicides or pesticides may be used at any time, only organic based materials.
- Gardens are accessible seven days a week during daylight hours.
- Participants must provide their own seeds, plants, fertilizer, and tools. Water is available on site.
- All plants must be contained within the boundary of each plot.
- Support structures for vines and other trailing plants are permitted and encouraged.
- No plants are permitted to extend outside your assigned plot(s), reach 6 feet high, or shade adjacent plots.
- All plots **MUST** be kept weed-free. Failure to do so will result in one warning, then forfeiture of your plot.
- If for any reason you are temporarily unable to maintain your plot, or you will have a substitute gardener, please inform The 712 Initiative.
- All weeds and plant waste must be placed in the compost pile.
- Only plant material is permitted in the compost pile – no trash.
- You cannot reassign your plot to anyone else.
- No personal sales are allowed on site.
- **NO PETS ARE ALLOWED.**
- Children must be supervised at all times.
- Plot holders are responsible for their children and guests.
- Absolutely no tampering with other gardeners' plots, plants, or produce.
- The contents of each plot belong to the assigned plot holder; however, the fruit from the Community Garden fruit trees are available to all. Please be responsible and respectful.
- **END OF GROWING SEASON** – Plot holders are responsible for completely removing all plant material from your plot(s). **ALL** plant material **MUST** be placed in the compost pile.

We encourage gardeners to enjoy a quiet, peaceful experience while gardening at the Creek Top Community Garden. Be respectful of other gardeners, their plots, and their experience.
